

# Show details

Welcome to the Danish Paint Horse Championship 2026. For the third year in a row with four judges at Vilhelmsborg, offering an attractive per horse weekend card and Early Bird discount.

## SHOW ORGANIZER AND TEAM

Paint Horse Club Denmark is the show organizer, and the entire show team is volunteering their time. All entry-related communication must be sent to [phcdkentry@gmail.com](mailto:phcdkentry@gmail.com). Please note that because the team is volunteer-run, response times may be a little longer.

## SHOW DATES

- In 2026 the show will be held May 23-25 (Saturday, Sunday on Monday)
- Paid Warm Up classes will be on May 22 (Friday)

## LOCATION

- Facility address: Vilhelmsborg, Bedervej 101, 8320 Mårslet, Denmark.

## ENTRY DEADLINES

- Early Bird entry period: April 1-12, 2026
- Standard Entry period: April 20- May 14, 2026

## ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- Arrival is possible from Thursday May 21, 2026, 3 PM.
- Horses and participants must leave the show no later than Monday 25 when the show ends.

# Early Bird discounts

Early Bird is an opportunity for all participants to receive a discount of DKK 1500 for APHA horses and DKK 800 for non APHA horses.

## EARLY BIRD ENTRY PERIOD

- April 1-12

## DOES YOUR ENTRY QUALIFY FOR EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT?

- The entry must include a stall for the horse
- APHA horses must select the APHA weekend card or APHA Young Horse weekend card
- 2026 PHCDK membership for one of the names on the entry (horse owner or rider(s))
  - If not at the time of entry, the membership option must be added during the entry
- Payment before the due date on the payment invoice

## SECOND HORSE ADDITIONAL DISCOUNT

In 2026 we introduce additional Early Bird benefits for participants bringing more than one horse. The second horse from the same owner entered during Early Bird receives these additional benefits: No show office fee of DKK 300 and a free tack stall. A third horse from the same owner only gets the DKK 300 show fee discount (not a free tack stall).

## QUALIFY FOR SECOND HORSE BENEFITS

- Identical owner of both horses (for APHA horses, an APHA Recorded Lessee counts as "Owner" for the purposes below)
  - Two APHA horses: identical APHA owner IDs
  - One APHA horse and one non APHA: the APHA owner name and the owner name of the non APHA horse must be identical
  - Two non APHA horses (eg. AQHA): identical AQHA owner ID for both horses
- The second horse must also meet all the general Early Bird criteria

# Price list groups

## EARLY BIRD

- **The discounts** are available to all horses, APHA and non-APHA, that meet the criteria.

## APHA HORSES

- **The Weekend Card** is a flatfee per horse allowing the horse to enter all eligible APHA classes across divisions for one and any additional horse/rider combinations.
  - The APHA Paynt Point fee is required per class in addition to the Weekend Card flatfee.
- **Single APHA class** is for horses without a Weekend Card. Breakpoints for when the Single APHA class option is cheaper than the Weekend Card: early Bird: horses entering only 1 APHA class. No Early Bird: horses entering 4 or fewer APHA classes.
  - In addition to the class fee, the APHA Paynt Point fee is required per class.
- **APHA Paynt Point Fee:** Every entry pays their own share of APHA Paynt Point fees based on the number of APHA classes entered. The fee is to cover that the show is required:
  - To Pay APHA a total of 12 USD every time a horse is entered in an APHA class: 4 USD show results fee and 8 USD Paynt Point fee.

## APHA AND NON APHA HORSES

- **PHCDK classes** are for all horses and riders to compete for the payout money, and the impressive trophies in young horse, equitation and ranch cup:
  - APHA horses can enter an additional class in their favorite disciplines
  - AQHA and other breeds can join the show in these classes
- **Paid Warm-Up classes** are open to all APHA and non-APHA horses.
- **Show office fee** is a fixed fee per entry for all APHA and non-APHA horses

## STALL & CAMPING

- **Every horse** attending the show must either pay for a stall (including deposit) or the facility fee. Please note that booking a stall with deposit is one of the Early Bird requirements.
- **Participants** staying at the showgrounds during the show must pay for camping, with or without electricity. Paid per RV/Camper/Tent.

## PAYMENT INVOICE

By submitting an entry form you agree to pay all fees. The show team manually reviews each entry before a payment invoice is issued. All invoices will be issued in DKK. The entry review is usually completed within 1–3 days. The payment invoice must be paid on or before the due date stated on the invoice.

## MISSING PAYMENT BY INVOICE DUE DATE

Each entry will receive one e-mail reminder to pay and to send a copy of the bank transfer receipt. If we still don't receive payment shortly after the reminder, the early bird discount will be removed.

# Entry Changes

It is possible to change an existing entry by sending an e-mail to [phcdkentry@gmail.com](mailto:phcdkentry@gmail.com) with the name of the horse and requested changes. Fee per change is DKK 50.

## **ADD RIDER AND/OR CLASSES**

Adding an additional rider or additional classes to an existing weekend card is possible by paying the change fee of DKK 50. Adding other additional options (eg. Tack stall or Camping) is also possible as seen in the price list and a change fee of DKK 50.

## **HORSE OR RIDER REPLACEMENT**

The change fee of DKK 50 also applies to replacement of horse OR rider for an existing entry.

# Stalls

Vilhelmsborg offers up to 84 permanent stalls in the main show barn across the road from the arena. Availability of stalls beyond the permanent stalls is not guaranteed.

## **DONATE STALL DEPOSIT TO PHCDK**

Support PHCDK by donating your stall deposit of DKK 300. When you are done showing, you can start loading and drive home - volunteers from the show team will clean your stall. Before the show PHCDK will share an online form for participants to let the show know if they want to donate their stall deposit. Participant who decide to request a refund, should note that all the bedding must be removed and the online form will require upload of an image of the clean stall.

## **STALL ALLOCATIONS**

Horses from the same Country/Trainer/Barn will be grouped together if possible. However, PHCDK cannot guarantee stall allocation requests can be fulfilled. A stall chart will be published before the show. PHCDK reserves the right to make changes and publish an updated stall chart. Only the latest version is valid.

## **TACK STALLS**

There is a limited amount of tack stalls available. Tack stalls include no bedding, it's an empty stall where you can store your hay/feed, show tack/clothing and add your own lock to the door. For safety reasons only a limited amount of items can be stored in front of each stall. Additional items must be stored in a tack stall or in the trailer at the designated parking area.

## **STALL OWNERSHIP**

When an entry is cancelled, with or without a vet certificate, the stall (and bedding) will be handed over to PHCDK and cannot be claimed or resold to other participants.

# Classes and Schedule

PHCDK reserves the right to reschedule classes and publish an updated show schedule. Only the latest version of the show schedule is valid. The show schedule is dynamic and its the responsibility of each entry to be ready for entered classes. Time estimates are only guidelines.

## **CANCELLATION OF CLASSES**

APHA and PHCDK Classes below 3 entries when the Early Bird Entry period closes, will be removed from the list of classes. Effected riders will receive an e-mail and the option to select another class.

## **ANNOUNCEMENT OF CLASS PLACINGS**

In placed classes, the placings of each individual judge will be announced. In scored classes, only the overall placings will be announced, calculated as stated in the section about Danish Champion titles. Individual judge placings can be seen when the scoresheets are published.

# Danish Champions

To qualify for Danish Champion titles, the rider must be current members of PHCDK. International PHCDK Members qualify for medals equal to Danish PHCDK members. There will be Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in each class depending on the number of entries.

## GOLD, SILVER AND BRONZE MEDALS

- **1 & 2 Entries:**
  - No titles will be awarded
- **3 & 4 Entries:**
  - Gold medal
- **5 Entries:**
  - Gold and Silver medal
- **6 & more Entries**
  - Gold, Silver and Bronze medal

## PLACED CLASSES (NO SCORESHEET)

All four judges' placings will count to calculate the medal winners. The placings will be added up using the following point scale:

## SCORED CLASSES

All four judges' scores will count in the calculations. The scores will be added up to a total score per horse. These total scores will be used to determine the medal winners in the class.

## RESOLVING TIES

There will be a tie-breaker judge per day. Any ties calculating medal winners in both placed and scored classes will be resolved by using the placing/score for the tie-breaker judge.

# General conditions

The organization reserves the right to make changes to the general terms and conditions, the list of classes, and the show dates, or to cancel the event if circumstances make this necessary.

## **APHA RULE BOOK**

The 2025 APHA Rulebook applies from arriving at the showgrounds and until leaving the show, including good horsemanship and sportsmanship. The Show Team and Show Manager has the authority to enforce all rules stated in APHA Rulebook and the show announcement at any time before, during and after the show.

## **HORSE PASSPORT AND VACCINATIONS**

- The horse has a valid passport and the UELN passport number is submitted with the entry
- The horse passport should be available upon request while the horse is at the facility
- The horse is disease-free and vaccinated according to the general rules. Proof of vaccinations should be available upon request
